## Subscription form to become Ordinary Member of the Quality Tracking Project (QTP) for the year 2016

The Quality Tracking Project aims to standardise the technical solution – via CEN ECISS/TC 109 - so that coil users can employ a single system on coils from all steel producers. The Standardisation work will run in parallel to the industrial roll out of the system.

Chosen by the founding members as independent governing body and approved by the EUROFER Vice-Presidents on 01/10/2015, EUROFER has taken over the coordination and management of the Quality Tracking Project formally since 01/02/2016.

At their meeting held at EUROFER offices on 04/03/2016, the QTP steering committee<sup>1</sup> – consisting out of ArcelorMittal, Tata Steel Europe, thyssenkrupp Steel Europe, voestalpine Stahl and Salzgitter Flachstahl - decided **the 2016 financial contribution for Ordinary Membership of the QTP is € 2,000**. The Ordinary Membership is open to all interested companies<sup>2</sup>.
